MINUTES

CALL TO ORDER

Meeting was called to order at 2:23 p.m. by CETF Chair, Rena Carlson-Lammers, DVM

1. Review and approval of changes to rule IDAPA 46.01.01.205

The following changes to rule 205 were reviewed:

1. 205.02.a.: Change “venous access” to “euthanasia techniques”.
2. 205.02.a.ii: Move to 205.02.c.i
3. 205.02.a.iii (1): Strike wording mandating IV injections on all dogs over three (3) months of age.
4. 205.02.a.iii (2): Strike wording requiring that animals undergoing IP injections must be held until unconscious, and checked every five (5) minutes until death occurs.
5. 205.02.a.v.1-4: Strike entire section that micromanages injections.
6. 205.02.a.vii: Strike reference to carbon monoxide-induced euthanasia chambers.
7. 205.02.c: Add wording “and humane treatment”.
8. 205.02.c.i: Remove reference to injected animals being lowered to the surface on which they are being held at time of injection.
9. 205.02.d: Revise reference for time an animal should become unconscious and show terminal signs to sixty (60) minutes for all types of injections.
10. 205.03.b: Strike reference to “assistant”.
11. 205.03.d: Revise wording regarding certificate invalidity upon employment termination.
12. 205.03.f: Revise wording to indicate that only CEA employer may request CET reinstatement.
13. 205.04.b: Add requirement that law enforcement CETs using chemical capture must recertify in remote chemical capture every third year.

Dr. McReynolds moved to accept current wording of Rule 205. Dr. Lancaster seconded. Motion passed.
